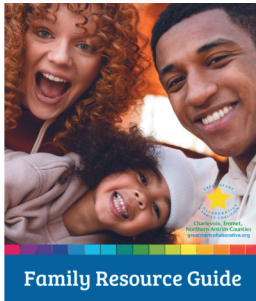

In order to register for assistance programs during the event, agencies ask that you bring as much of the following info as you have available, including picture ID, social security card, discharge papers (DD214), proof of income, Medicaid/Medicare or private insurance info.

EDUCATION & EMPLOYMENT

Information about adult education opportunities, financial aid resources, résumé development, employment services and skills training services, as well as on-site job application for local businesses.



FOOD & NUTRITION

Nutrition information and education programs, local food and food pantry resources, help with applying for the food assistance program (SNAP), and snack bags to take home.

HEALTH & WELLNESS

Blood pressure checks, blood sugar checks and breast exams. Immunization record review along with COVID and flu immunizations. COVID test kits and Narcan. Resources for substance use disorder, cancer and diabetes awareness and prevention, suicide prevention, and pregnancy prevention. Medicare and Medicaid enrollment assistance.

HOUSING & FINANCE

Counseling and workshop resources focusing on home ownership, credit education, budget building and foreclosure services. Heat and energy assistance including emergency financial assistance with rent and utilities. Info on loans and grants for home repair. Banking as well as tax preparation and filing resources.

KIDS & PARENTING

Info on pregnancy, birth/postpartum doula, parenting education, early childhood development, tuition-free preschool, day care including resources for college students who are parents. Also resources for youth programs, summer camps and babysitter training. Free child care items and drug test kits for teens.

SOCIAL SERVICES

Mediation advice on parenting time, divorce, IEP for kids. Info on senior services including meals for seniors, grief support, Hospice information. Support for individuals and families with disabilities. Local library services. Support for abuse survivors. Info on transportation. Assistance programs focused on members of the LTBB of Odawa Indians.

VETERANS CORNER

Connecting Veterans and their families to resources for VA benefits/disability claims, homelessness, justice outreach, suicide prevention, financial assistance during a crisis, and DD214 retrieval assistance.
